Injectable Solution

Composition: each 1 ml contains

Enrofloxacin 100 mg

Description:

Enrofloxacin belongs to the group of fluoroquinolones and acts bactericidal against both gram-positive bacteria and gram-negative bacteria. It is also active against Mycoplasma.

Indications:

Gastrointestinal, respiratory and urinary tract infections, caused by microorganisms susceptible to enrofloxacin (pasteurella, salmonella, mycoplasma, E-coli, Campylobacter, and Haemophilus) in camels, cattle, sheep and goats.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Enrofloxacin
- Animals with liver or renal failure

Side effects:

Hypersensitivity reactions.

Interactions:

Not to be administrated together with Tetracyclines, Chloramphenicol, Macrolides and Lincosamides.

Usage:

For intramuscular and subcutaneous injection

Dosage:

The general dose: 1 ml per 40 kg body weight for 4-5days

Withdrawal period:

Meat: 21 days Milk: 4 Days

Storage conditions:

Store in airtight containers, in a moderate temperature (15-25 C) and protect

from direct sunlight

Packing:

Vial of 100 ml.
