## **Injectable Solution**

**Composition:** 

Each ml contains:

Tylosin Tartrate 200 mg

**Description:** 

Tylosin, a macrolide antibiotic, is active against particularly gram-positive bacteria, some Spirochetes (including Leptospira), Actinomyces, Mycoplasmas, Haemophilus pertussis, and some gram-negative cocci. After parenteral administration, therapeutically active blood concentrations of Tylosin are reached within two hours.

#### Indications:

Infections caused by micro-organisms susceptible to Tylosin : (in cattle, calves, sheep, goats)

- respiratory tract infections.
- dysentery
- arthritis
- mastitis
- endometritis.
- shipping fever
- pneumonia
- foot rot
- bronchitis
- post surgery operation infections

## **Contraindications:**

Hypersensitivity to Tylosin.

### Interactions:

Avoid administration with penicillines, cephalosporines, or quinolones

### Usage:

For intramuscular injection

#### Dosage:

The general dose is: 1 ml per 20 kg body weight daily for 3-5 days.

#### Withdrawal Period:

Meat: 10 days Milk: 4 days.

# **Storage conditions:**

Store in airtight containers, in a moderate temperature (15-25 C) and protect from direct sunlight .

### Packing:

Vial of 100 ml.
